NAON invites you to submit a podium or poster presentation proposal for the **45**th **Annual Congress**. This conference provides opportunities to share and gain knowledge, expertise and perspectives through collaborative education and various modalities. NAON prioritizes inter-professional proposals. Perspectives from nurses, physicians, nurse practitioners, therapists and case managers/navigators add value to the education.

Submission Process

Carefully follow the online directions when submitting presentation proposals; incomplete proposals will be disqualified from consideration. It is the responsibility of the submitter to save their work through the application process and to ensure the online proposal is complete. Each accepted presentation will include a live component, such as a real-time Q&A session to directly engage with the audience.

Submission Deadlines

- Podium Presentation Proposals are due by August 19, 2024
- Poster Presentation Proposals are due by September 16, 2024

Reviewers score proposals using the following criteria:

- Proposal appearance and completion
- Title
- Completed <u>Bio/Relevant Financial Interest</u> and <u>Education Planning</u> forms
- Learner Need or Practice Gap
- Detailed Summary of Content
- Measurable Outcomes/objectives and content
- Orthopaedic innovation
- Evidence-based practice
- Relevance to orthopaedic nursing
- Support for Congress learner outcomes
- Minimum of 3 references
- Educational level
- Track and topic, as well as number of same topic submissions
- Category A or B
- Free of product/drug bias
- Research proposals additionally require background, problem and purpose, methodology, sample, results, limitations, conclusions and implications (please include in abstract).

NOTE: A proposal can be for either a podium or poster presentation, but not both. NAON does not accept any presentation or poster with bias or product promotion.
